

Covid19 Rules for Easter School

We need to remember that people are coming from all over the country, people who we may not know and people whose range of contacts we do not know. We will be indoors, in relative proximity, for sustained periods of time.

Pre School

1. You need to have a negative RAT taken within 72 hours of the start of the School; effectively this means on Wednesday 13 April or Thursday 14 April, and you may need to plan for this.
2. Even if you have a negative RAT, if you have symptoms, don't come.

At School

3. All ventilation must be open.
4. Masks must be worn, except when eating or drinking.
5. If you develop symptoms, take a RAT (we will have supplies on hand). If you test positive, you will need to remove from the School, isolate and follow Public Health requirements; those in your "household" (i.e., in shared accommodation) will also need to isolate.

All registrants have confirmed their vaccination status (fully vaccinated and boosted); follow these simple rules and we will have a safe and enjoyable time!
